### Make a difference

Your Will is an important expression of your wishes. It enables you to recognise family and friends as well as acknowledge others close to your heart. By leaving a gift in your Will to Bayley House you will:

- » Help people with an intellectual disability achieve their goals and aspirations
- » Create opportunities for new experiences and increased independence
- » Enable more people to access the specialist services we offer
- » Facilitate skill development and program innovation
- » Increase training opportunities for staff and volunteers, improving the quality of the service we deliver
- » Improve facilities and upgrade items of equipment
- » Raise the level of community awareness, encouraging more people to support us
- » Expand the accommodation options available to people with a disability who can no longer live at home

### Types of bequests

A gift through your Will can take various forms:

- » The residue of the estate
- » A percentage of your estate
- » A specified amount of money
- » A life insurance or superannuation policy
- » A nominated asset such as shares or real estate, works of art or jewellery
- » An investment in perpetuity

If you are able to help Bayley House through a bequest we recommend you seek professional advice from a solicitor or financial advisor to ensure your bequest is clearly and legally stated. Bequests can be left for general purposes or a specific project.


